1. Trust Transfer:

Whilst some details are still being completed the new Somerton Recreation Ground Trust took over the running of the fields on 1st April 2019 as planned. The Dowry payment from STC was received later in April.

2. Trustee Appointments:

- whilst the selection process for the remaining 'appointed Trustees' was put on hold until the completion of the transfer of Trust assets had been confirmed. This process will be restarted shortly, and we would like to apologise to the applicants for the delay.

3. Trust Meeting:

The first Trust meeting was held on the 15th April and whilst full minutes will be available, we can confirm in the meantime that David Osmond and Ray Thompson were elected as Chair and Treasurer respectively.

4. Speciality and Support Roles and Volunteers

The new Trust will need all the help that it can get to try to ensure that it achieves its goal of maximising the benefits of the Recreation Ground for improving the conditions of life for all of the inhabitants of Somerton. 5. David Wilson Development

Meanwhile, the new Trust have already taken steps to get a grip on progress with the new David Wilson Pitch. A very productive meeting was set up with representatives of David Wilson Homes; South Somerset District Council; and Swan Paul the landscaping consultants who helped create the previous 5-year plan. The result of the meeting was that we now have a full and detailed specification of the pitch to be delivered; the full support of SSDC in ensuring that it is delivered to spec; and an inspection and review process to monitor progress. This is a significant step forward from where we were.

6. SRGT Development Plan

Further, following clarification of the matters mentioned above Swan Paul have now been instructed to update the 'Masterplan' drawings for the fields to take account of the new pitch and the connection to the new amenity land to the South West.

7. Annual Parish Meeting Presentation

The new Trust have been invited to present to the Annual Parish Meeting which will be held at Edgar Hall on the evening of Thursday 30th May. This should be a great opportunity to present the Masterplan drawings to the community and to collect feed back.

8. Finances

We are obviously very aware of the need for the Trust to run on a financially sound basis and to this end we aim to ensure that all operating costs are funded from operational income streams.

Our income is generated in several ways – Pitch Fees; Sports Club rent; Event Fees; MUGA rental; Sponsorship; and an annual grant from Somerton Town Council. This grant has been reduced from £12500 to £7000 this year.

Pinning down our operational costs in the new structure has been challenging with several areas of cost that were not paid by the previous RGMC only becoming manifest in the latter stages of the transfer process. We now expect to see a significant increase in operational costs in the new Trust compared to the previous RGMC and this is causing us some concern.

Costs include Grounds Maintenance where we have already engineered a saving; Utilities where we are seeing a substantial increase as we take over services that were previously paid by the Sports Club; Insurance where there is another substantial increase as we take responsibility for the Clubhouse building; and Building Maintenance which was not previously handled by the RGMC.

It goes without saying that we are working very hard to increase revenues and reduce costs.

Outside of our operational costs and income; the new Development Plan will create a 'wishlist' of projects and improvements desired for the future. We will treat each one separately and seek the appropriate support from relevant funding bodies.
